BS 10012:2017 specification for a personal information management system was revised in 2017 specifically to address the privacy requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Personal data is any information by which a living person can be identified, directly or indirectly, such as a name, personal record, image or online identifier.

Additionally, ISO 27001:2013 certification can provide the technical and organisational methods and controls required to demonstrate compliance to the GDPR requirements.

BS 10012:2017 addresses the data privacy controls required to comply with the GDPR. ISO 27001 specification for an information security management system addresses the required information security controls. Together they address many of the requirements of the GDPR and are recognised as best practice for demonstrating progress being made towards GDPR compliance. Operational efficiencies are possible by taking an integrated approach with both BS 10012 and ISO 27001 certification.
