



COSMETIC PRODUCTS REGULATION (EC) 1223/2009 AWARENESS TRAINING COURSE

COURSE PROFILE

This awareness course provides an overview of the key requirements of the Regulation. This is particularly relevant for those organisations that sell cosmetic products to European Commission member states as compliance with the Regulation is a legal requirement. It will inform about the special obligations for any organisation who places cosmetic products on the EC market including product safety and registration with the regulatory authorities. Several practical cases will be highlighted during the course.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Explain the Cosmetic Product Regulation as applied for cosmetic product producers
- Understand the key requirements of the Regulation
- Understand the practical implications for manufacturing facilities and own-brand labellers

DESCRIPTION

Regulation (EC) 1223/2009 on cosmetic products is the main regulatory framework for finished cosmetic products when placed on the EU market. This course describes the key requirements of the Regulation and how to apply them in a facility that either produces finished cosmetic products or owns the brand of a cosmetic product and outsources its production.
